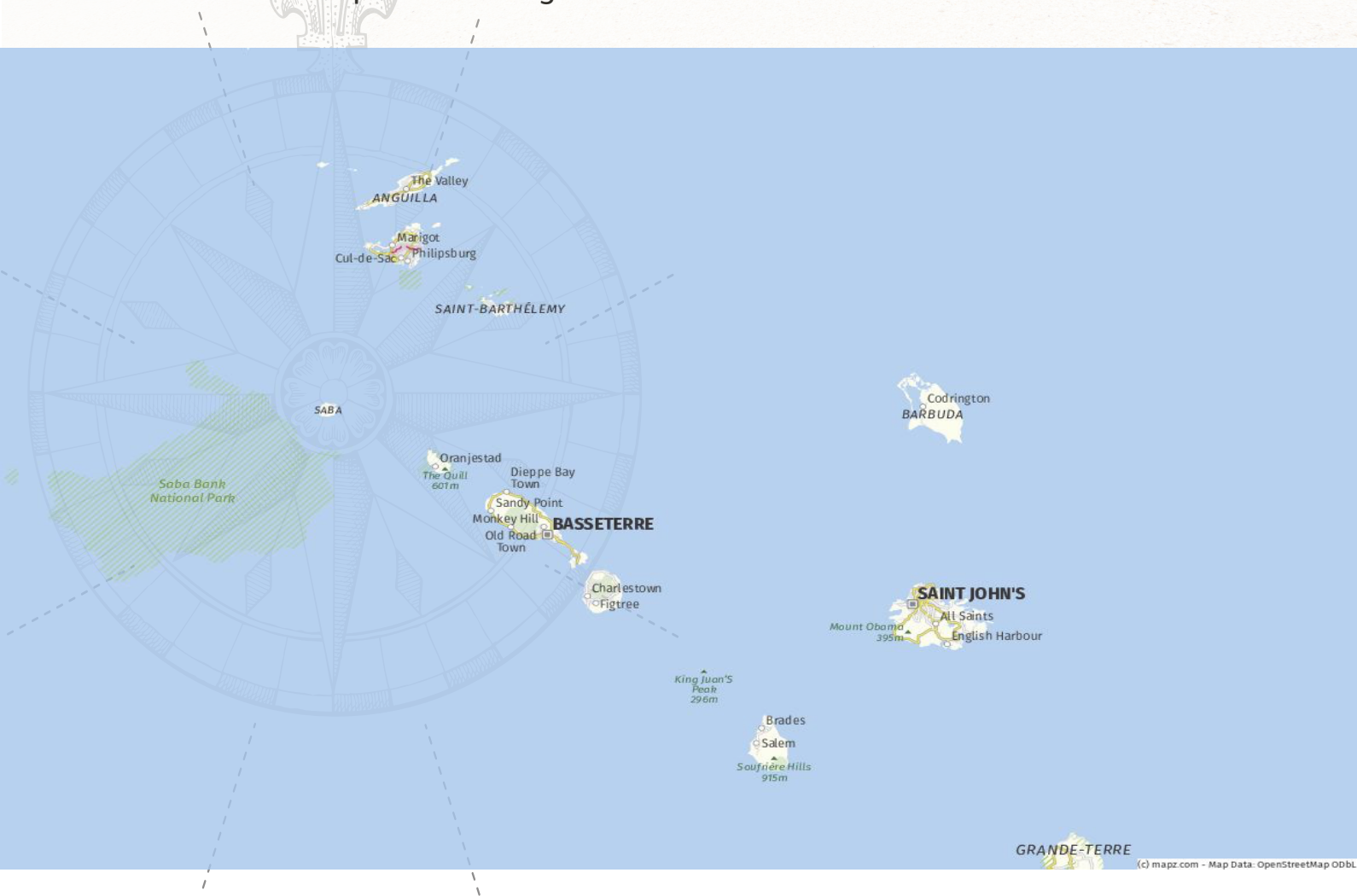
The Route

You will join the ship on a Saturday in Antigua. Revel in Sunday at Shirley Heights with its spectacular views while dancing to steel drums and drinking the local rum punch, Monday can be a lazy beach day. After spending our first few days enjoying the island we will set sail heading north. Our only commitment is arriving in St.Martin (approx 200nm) before the 29th of February.

These diverse islands are famous for their beaches, flowing rum punches and reggae, marine parks brimming with colourful corals, tropical fish, turtles and sharks, and majestic national parks abundant with overgrown tropical forests home to many protected rare and exotic wildlife.

The distances between the islands are 10 to 65 nautical miles.
The steady trade winds from the Atlantic normally are between 15 to 20 knots which should allow for near perfect sailing conditions.

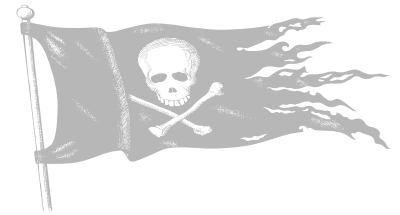

Antigua:

Home to 365 beaches and the iconic Nelson's Dockyard (UNESCO) and Shirley Heights, Antigua is definitely a place to have fun!

Kitts & Nevis:

This pair of islands offers everything from the impressive Brimstone Hill Fortress (UNESCO), a round of golf, to rum punches on the beach and impressive landscapes and tropical vegetation.

Sint Eustatius (Statia):

Priding itself with ecotourism (STENAPA), the Quill is home to over 35 endangered or rare species and is overgrown with tropical rainforest. The real treasure lies beneath the surface of the water though. Its protected Marine Park is a diver's paradise.

Saba:

This impressive volcano rises from the sea. Probably the reason that it was used as 'Skull Island' from the 1933 original King Kong movie. Unforgettable marine life is hidden below the waterline. Colourful corals, tropical fish, turtles and even sharks.

St. Barthelemy:

An escape destination for the rich and famous. Gustavia tiny streets are lined with posh boutiques and restaurants. Luxury yachts line the marina and the bays. The famous Nikki beach is a hotspot for beach goers and cocktails. \$\$\$

St.Martin & Sint Maarten:

The famous Maho beach where people flock to experience the famous airplane landings

The trip will include many highlights and a bit of adventure.

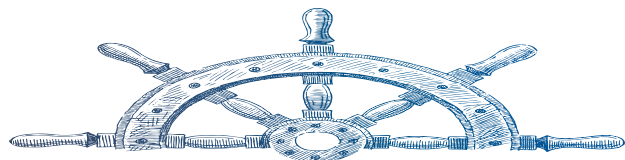


Meals

Boarding time is 18:00. Exact location will be determined on the day of arrival. You will be notified by mobile or by AIS (marine traffic on the internet).

Disembarkation: Sat. 29/02/2020 in Saint Martin after breakfast at 09:00.

The price does not include: passports or visas, travel insurance, any local taxes including departure and landing tax, personal clothing, medical expenses, items of a personal nature, drinks, alcohol and individual arrangements for travel to or from point of departure or arrival.

This price does not include: land excursions, entrance fees into nature reserves, extra recreational fees including organised diving and snorkelling, extra harbour fees, and extra services.

Booking:

50% of the travel price is required for a deposit and the balance due 60 days before departure.

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Cancellation:

Your deposit will be non-refundable after the date of booking. If you cancel your booking 45 days or more before the date of departure we will refund 50% of money paid, excluding your deposit. If a cancellation is made within 45 days of departure no refund will be made.

Miscellaneous:

Each participant requires a passport that is valid for a minimum of 6 months before travelling, travel health insurance, and a medical certificate. You should be healthy and fit (see voyage crew form), have visited a dentist before travelling, and have the necessary vaccinations. Just drop a line to Captain Rony and he will gladly advise you personally if this is the right adventure for you.
